



DISPUTE RESOLUTION POLICY

The Manitoba Cycling Association (MCA) supports the principle of internal dispute resolution and is committed to the use of mediation and/or arbitration to resolve disputes rather than resorting to the uncertainty and costs associated with litigation.

Internal mediation may be pursued at any point in a dispute where the parties to the dispute mutually agree.

In cases where internal mediation fails to resolve the dispute binding arbitration should be pursued with an independent arbitrator who is acceptable to the parties. The parties shall agree in advance and in writing that;

- The decision of the arbitrator will be final and binding
- No legal action will be undertaken in relation to the dispute
