## **2019 Provincial Criterium Championships**

The MCA is pleased to announce that the 2019 Provincial Criterium Championships will take place on Saturday August 24, 2019

**Date:** Saturday August 24, 2019

**Host Club:** Manitoba Cycling Provincial Program

**Race Organizer:** Jayson Gillespie (204-333-5503; [cycling.coach@sportmanitoba.ca](mailto:cycling.coach@sportmanitoba.ca))

**Location:** Southern Portion of Grand Point. Registration will take place at 588 Bernat Road, between Hallama Drive and Oak Grove Road.

**Race Course:** The race will take place on the continuous loop involving Oak Grove Road and Discovery Drive, in the Grande Point Industrial Acres, located South of Grand Pointe.

**Parking:** Parking is available in the parking area at 588 Bernat Road.

**Registration: A UCI Racing License is required.** You must hold a valid UCI race license. Riders with a UCI racing license issued by a cycling federation other than Manitoba (including other countries) may compete but are not eligible for medals. Day licenses are not available for provincial events.

**Cost:**

- On Site Registration only
- \$20 per individual event or \$50 for all 3 events
- Full payment must accompany registration.

**Sign-In / Registration:** All racers must still sign-in on race day. All riders must show their license to the commissaries. **Sign-in / Registration will start at 12:00pm and will close 30min before your race start time.**

**Washrooms:** Washrooms are available nearby at Grand Point Park

**Race Duration:**

- Age categories are determined by your age as of December 31, 2019.
- A number of categories may race together, but you compete only against others in your age and sex category.

## **Groups and Start Times**

- **1:30pm** - Race #1 (45min + 3 laps) – Jr Men, Espoir Men, Sr Men, Men 30+
- **2:30pm** - Race #2 (40 min +3 laps) – Espoir Women, Sr Women, Men 40+, Men 50+
- **3:15pm** - Race #3 (30 min + 3 laps) – Wmn U15 & U17, Jr Wmn, Master Wmn, Men U15 & U17, Men 60+

**Medals:** will be awarded to the top 3 riders in each category, medal ceremony will take place after the conclusion of all races.

## **Official Notes:**

- No rider support vehicles are allowed on the course except for those provided by the organizer.
- Provincials is an extremely competitive event, but it is a sporting event and rules of sportsmanship prevail:
  - Riders have a responsibility to look after one another's safety.
  - Riders have a responsibility to ensure there is adequate space before attempting to pass between or around other riders.
  - Riders shall not intentionally impede the progress of other riders
