* This is a summary of proposed regulations. Complete bike regulations can be found on the UCI web site. The committee reserves the right to make changes as necessary.

** The more open regulations regarding equipment will apply to the citizen's category and only the lowest category for riders with a UCI race licence. The closer adherence to UCI regulations will apply to all higher categories. As of 2010 there are two categories for riders with race licences (A and B) so B is allowed the looser equipment regulations. In the future should there be A, B, and C categories for riders with race licences then the more stringent regulations would apply to A and B, and the less stringent to C.

*** In short, wider tires than mandated by UCI will be allowed. All other bike regulations followed.
