Actif Epica is a 130 km epic bike race across the prairie on the historic Crow Wing Trail (part of the Trans Canada Trail) in southeast Manitoba from St. Malo to Winnipeg's French quarter, St. Boniface. Race checkpoints will connect racers to the communities of St. Pierre-Jolys, Otterburne, Niverville, St. Adolphe and Winnipeg. This will be an extremely challenging race – finish times will be in the 10 to 20 hour range, depending on conditions. - A few very dedicated and enthusiastic individuals have put in hundreds of combined hours to ensure this unique event is the best it can possibly be. The final registration of 39 racers indicated a strong interest in competitive winter cycling. Notable names including Alex Man, Paul Lapointe and the solo female entry Andrea Tetrault "cycle chic". - The mandatory gear check and spaghetti dinner takes place on Friday February 17th, and you can come by to marvel at their athletic prowess, contemplate their tenacity or just wish the racers good luck.
