Accomplishments									
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • First Sports Program funding was used to purchase BMX bikes and a shipping container for the BMX clinics. We also used the North End Community Renewal Corporation funding to purchase the 2 lane practise startgate and a portion of the BMX helmet purchase. We have conducted 2 introductory BMX clinics at the North Centennial Recreation and Leisure Center to date and plan to expand the number and location of clinics for next year. • We had a meeting with the City of Winnipeg and presented our business plan for the North Centennial Recreation and Leisure Center site of the BMX track.
