

Operating Principles:

- Stakeholders will be consulted and have a voice
- Committees are the representative voice of our stakeholders
- Committee collaboration ensures that all voices are heard and influence the decisions that are made.
- Ideas and concerns should be directed according to the organizational chart.
- The board is responsible for the overall direction
- Decisions are disseminated and explained to all applicable stakeholders

Clarifying Roles



- MCA:
 - Provides structure to organize cycling community
 - Facilitates and communicates activities
 - Funds development of volunteers see Development Fund
 - Provide standards and insurance for races
 - Information and feedback travel from Board to committees to clubs and members (and visa versa)
- Clubs:
 - Select and mentor volunteers
 - Organize races and club rides
 - Select a club rep for committees
- Members:
 - Ride and race to your hearts content!
 - Engage and contribute to your clubs activities (coach, race organizer, club ride organizer, race commissaire or marshall)
