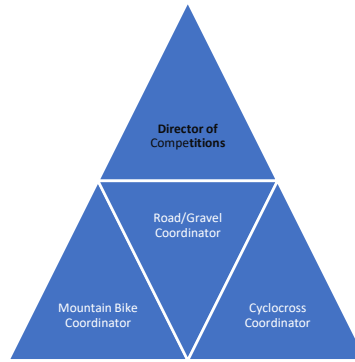

Race Disciplines:

The goal is to recruit a Director of Competitions volunteer to help support the three race director positions. The race directors will continue to chair a race discipline committee for each of their sports. The Director of Competitions will assist with duties including leading the race calendar meeting for all sports, ensuring technical guides are updated, ensure overall communications are clear and concise, and attend monthly board meetings.
