## 1. MCA Club Development grant:

- 7. Event Support:
  - MCA Sanctions events, thus covers the organizer, participants, volunteers, and spectators.
  - MCA provides (free of charge) a certificate of insurance when organizers are required to show proof of insurance to landowners, sponsors etc.

- Race Directors and MCA staff provide support and expertise to organizers. The coordination of an annual event calendar, Race discipline technical guide, and networking opportunities with other club leads fosters best practises, club collaboration, and an increase of participation.
- Club promotion for sanctioned events is supported on mbcycling.ca as well as our social media channels to help increase participation.
- Race Equipment is available for sanctioned events free of charge (signage, pylons, vests, etc.)
- Race supplies are provided to clubs free of charge: Race numbers, provincial medals.
- Club commissaires are supported with training, mentorship, technical license reimbursement, and uniforms.
- Commissaires are available to clubs for sanctioned events to assist organizers with timing + results, rules + regs, a risk management. Small fee applies.
- Race Results are posted to the MCA website for individuals and clubs.
- 8. Meeting Rooms:
  - Clubs have access to meeting space and meeting equipment free of charge at the Sport for Life Centre. Contact the MCA office to book your space 204-925-5686

## 9. Insurance:

- \$10M General Liability Insurance is provided for Club activities that are pre-approved in advance to them happening. Please provide the MCA with a schedule of your activities. See Club Activity section of website for further information.
