Athlete Eligibility


- Members of the Manitoba Cycling Association
- Open to male and female athletes in the following age categories:
 - 11 and 12 years of age as of December 31, 2024, born in 2012 or 2013 (U13)
 - 13 and 14 years of age as of December 31, 2024, born in 2010 or 2011 (U15)



Regional Teams

- Each region will have
 - 2 males and 2 females from each age category (U13 and U15).
- Each region will also be comprised of one coach and one manager
- Regions: East, South, West, Winnipeg (x2); (no North)

Regional Qualifiers/Selection Races

- 5 confirmed qualifying/selection races POSTED on MCA website. Registration through the Race event's general registration under the category "U13/U15 MB Summer Games Qualifer"
 - Grand Beach Sun, May 5, 2024

 - Falcon Ridge Sat, May 18, 2024
 Neepawa (Hylife Back 40) June 8, 2024
 - Minnedosa (Squirrel Hills) June 9, 2024
 - Schinken Vad (Thornhill)- June 15, 2024
- Athletes must participate in <u>at least 1</u> event
 - Best 4 of 5 race results will be tabulated for Games selection rankings. Bonus points if race in all qualifier races. Bonus points for athletes that race in all 5 qualifier races.
- The top 2 racers in **both** genders and **both** age categories from each region will automatically qualify for their Regional Team.



Athlete Fill Policy

- The MCA will regulate fills using the list of qualifying athletes obtained once all qualifying events are complete. The list of qualifying athletes will consist of the following:
 - All first and second place finishers in all four categories (age group and gender)
 - All third place finishers in all four categories ("Fill" athletes)
 - Any additional athletes who may desire to attend the Games as recommended by a regional coach ("Fill" athletes)
- Athlete fill positions will be distributed equally and fairly among regional teams. Only eligible athletes from their respective categories, (age and gender), will be used as "fills". The intent is to fill by gender and category first, if positions are still vacant then cross category and cross gender fills will be assigned based on MCA approval



Athlete Fill Policy

- Fill Athletes will compete in their own category, (age and gender), for their respective regional team.
- A Regional team *may* have more than the standard number of competitors for a category (e.g., more than two U13 boys) *only if* other regional teams have fewer than the allocated numbers for that same category.
- A Regional team may have more than the allotted # of athletes by gender within a Category if other Regional teams are not able to fill their compliment.
- The MCA will determine the number of athlete fill positions available.
- The third place fill athletes will be ranked equally for each regional team, i.e. all third place competitors from their regional qualifiers will be randomly drawn to fill the available category spots.
- Once all category and gender fill positions have been assigned to qualified category and gender athletes, leftover fill positions will then be drawn by qualified category and alternate gender athletes on the qualified list f fill athletes.
- There will be a maximum of 40 athletes competing if all categories are completely filled.



Athletes / Coaches / Managers

- Athletes will be selected / offered spots for the regional teams as outlined in the technical guide.
- Team selection will be done by June 30, 2024
- Athletes will need to be registered for the MB Games by mid July
 - Cost for registration TBD (~\$250)
- Expect the team training by the Regional Coaches to occur over the months of late June July leading up the start of the games
- Transportation to and from the MB Games for athletes, coaches and managers & 1 bike will be provided from each regional hub (exception: athletes living within 150 km of Dauphin will be responsible for their own transportation). Transportation of bikes and athletes to sports venues during the games are provided.
- Athletes, Coaches, Managers will be staying in the Athletes Village(s) included in registration
- Food provided available in Athletes Village(s) included in registration

Athletes will each have 2 races - XCO (cross country) and XCC (short track)

XCO and XCC races will be on different days

U13 and U15 will have separate races (ie. not on the course at the same time)
