Issues Resolved

Key to help everyone sees things from all perspectives. • Improved turnaround time for race information for officials and participants, which also helps with race promotion. • Changes to the category changes for Cyclocross and rebalancing of the number of people in each race category. • We have a draft race calendar out to all the race organizers for 2026 with the hopes of having a confirmed calendar before the end of 2025	



Goals for Next Year

Plans for 2026 and beyond.

- Standardized tech guides for all race disciplines to make it easier for new race directors to complete and ensure that everyone gets the information they need in a format that makes sense.
- Early confirmation of the 2027 race calendar
- Improved category change request processing and guidelines for all race disciplines
- A New race director mentorship program
- Review of the tech manual for each discipline
- Update the awards criteria and guidelines to simplify the process of picking award winners.
